John R. Gibbs Scholarship for Innovation

The John R. Gibbs Scholarship for Innovation is open to either a full-time undergraduate student or a full-time graduate student current enrolled in the IU School of Informatics and Computing. The student must be in good standing with a record of academic excellence and a minimum GPA of 3.5. Preference is given to those who have demonstrated or expressed a stated interest in innovation and entrepreneurship. The scholarship is applied to the recipient’s bursar account at the beginning of each semester in which it is awarded.

Requirements:

- Must be either a full-time undergraduate student or full-time graduate student in IU School of Informatics and Computing
- Must be a student in good standing and have a minimum GPA of 3.5
- Must submit required information listed below
- Preference is given to those who have demonstrated or expressed a stated interest in innovation and entrepreneurship.

Award amount: \$1,000 per year (\$500 fall semester, \$500 spring semester)
Only one scholarship will be awarded, EITHER to an undergraduate student OR a graduate student, but not both.

Deadline: March 15

To apply:

For consideration, applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed application information (below) and Applicant Statement (see page 2 of this application)
2. Resume

Letter(s) of Recommendation. A minimum of one, but no more than 2 letters of recommendation from educators and/or employers who are familiar with your background should be sent via email to soicawrd@iupui.edu by the deadline.
