### Perseverance Scholarship

The Perseverance Scholarship is open to undergraduate students currently enrolled in the IU School of Informatics and Computing. The student must be in good standing who can demonstrate success during a challenging life event—or upon returning to the School of Informatics and Computing after enduring a difficult life event. The scholarship is applied to the recipient’s bursar account at the beginning of each semester in which it is awarded.

**Requirements:**

- Must be an undergraduate student in IU School of Informatics and Computing
- Must be a student in good standing and can demonstrate success during a challenging life event or upon returning to the School of Informatics and Computing after enduring a difficult life event
- Must submit required information listed below

**Award amount:** \$750 per year (divided evenly between fall and spring semesters)

**Deadline:** March 31<sup>st</sup>

For consideration, applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed application information (below) and Applicant Statement (see page 2 of this application)
2. Resume
